Jinhee Park established SINGLE speed DESIGN in 2001. Her award winning work pursues the convergence of form and content: Instead of an additive layering of issues of site, structure, program, history, and sustainability, a convergence of these disciplines is explored so that minimum form can take maximum effect across a broad range of disciplines. Jinhee's recent and current work such as the 8 Towers, the Big Dig Building, Soft Lofts, and HBNY (parenthetical space) has allowed her to become an emerging leader in innovative sustainable design. Along with being published in major media such as Metropolis Magazine, Dwell Magazine, The New Yorker, and PBS, she has received many prestigious design awards including the AIA Young Architects Award (2009), the Young Architects Forum Award by the Architectural League of NY (2007), an Holcim Foundation for Sustainable Construction Award (2005), The Metropolis Next Generation Prize (2004), and six AIA awards (2003-2006). Recently her firm was selected as one of 100 architects from around the globe to participate in the Ordos 100 project in Mongolia.

Jinhee Park received a Master in Architecture from the Harvard Design School and a B.F.A. in Industrial Design from Seoul National University. She is an active AIA member having served as an awards jury member and is NCARB certified.
