Gwynne Pugh has been practicing architecture, planning, civil and structural engineering since 1971. Co-founder of the firm Pugh + Scarpa, he is responsible for the general project administration, design review, technical and production management of all of their projects. Mr. Pugh is a past Chair and current member of the Santa Monica Planning Commission, which is undertaking a Land Use & Circulation Element Update in order to generate a new code for the City that will encourage design excellence in future developments and provide public benefit to the community. He is a Peer Review Consultant to the City of Carson, Long Beach Redevelopment Agency, and City of Los Angeles as well as the Getty Conservation Institute. As the City of San Diego Centre City Development Corporation's lead urban design consultant, Mr. Pugh reviews all large-scale projects in downtown San Diego. He is a LEED Accredited Professional, and is considered an expert in sustainable design and engineering.

Since Pugh + Scarpa's inception, a substantial majority of its projects which have reached the construction document stage have been built. It is Mr. Pugh's strong abilities, particularly on large projects with numerous consultants and complex building programs, which have made this impressive statistic possible. Highly skilled at coordinating agencies and consultants, Mr. Pugh's contribution to the firm's projects guarantees smooth teamwork from start to finish. After completing his engineering degree at Leeds he received a three year scholarship to study architecture at UCLA. Concurrently he worked at Wynne Engineering where he was involved in land development and civil and structural engineering design throughout California. While working at Bardwell, Case, & Gilbert he worked on residential and mid scale commercial projects He was project manager for a 100,000 square foot conference and entertainment center at the Disneyland Hotel for I.K. Weber. He has subsequently designed projects for the Disneyland Hotel, Seven-Up, Coca-Cola, the Getty Conservation Institute, Santa Monica College, the

City of Santa Monica, City of Carson, City of Upland, City of Palmdale, City of Los Angeles, City of Alhambra, County of Los Angeles, Los Angeles Community College District as well as numerous other cities and Institutions.
